



Terms and Conditions 2026

The following Terms and Conditions are established by Alpine Performance Racing and are applicable to all customers and sales from the period:

1st May 2026 – 1st October 2026

1. Appropriate alpine ski race training insurance, travel and medical insurance is mandatory for the duration of the athlete's trip.
2. In the event of cancellation or curtailment of a booking, as a result of the advice/restrictions from UK or host country Government, local government or other official organisations, Alpine Performance Racing is unable to provide a refund for the lost period. We strongly recommend you take out cancellation/curtailment insurance.
3. Alpine Performance Racing will not be responsible for cancellation or curtailment of a booking because of the inability to ski because of
 - (i) weather conditions
 - (ii) restrictions imposed by the resort / local government such as lift closures

APR may attempt to arrange alternative provision and you will be advised of any additional costs before accepting the alternative. Every attempt will be made to refund you the maximum amount after unavoidable costs have been endured.

4. It is compulsory for ALL athletes to acknowledge and sign the 2026 code of conduct. If the Code of Conduct is not adhered to and the athlete is required to go home (See Disciplinary Policy), APR will not be liable for any additional costs that incur. The payee is liable to pay for the remaining days in the block booking. Athletes are required to always follow the 'House Rules'. These are set out prior to commencement of training and are available at all times.
5. Injury – If an athlete is injured whilst out on camp or prior to the camp commencing (Within 28 days), payees are liable for the full balance of any invoices in relation to the following 28 days after notice.
6. APR are not responsible for theft/loss of any ski equipment or clothing.

7. APR will not be responsible for any additional costs/charges that there may be as a result of a change in arrangements, planning etc. that is related to any incidents/causes that are outside of APR control e.g. additional hotel or transport costs, should there be a need to make alternative travel arrangements.
8. Full payment of invoice must be settled a minimum of 28 days before the start of the booking. Athletes will not be permitted to attend camps if the full balance has not been received.
9. All athletes registered with APR are required to be enrolled in an educational establishment (This can be a UK school or an official online educational provider).
10. Athletes who attend a minimum of 3 weeks during the winter season must be registered as 'APR' via their home nations for their selected snow BASS affiliated club.
11. It is the **responsibility of the parent** to ensure that they have completed all necessary travel documentation and complied with all legislation, regulations and testing (If required), particularly in relation to Schengen Visa/area limitations, passport validity requirements and any additional health related restrictions/requirements.

APR takes no responsibility for overstaying the allowed time in any country, we cannot indemnify any individuals who break legislation in relation to any country's travel or visa restrictions. We recommend using <https://www.visa-calculator.com> to calculate your stay in the Schengen area and do not condone staying more than the allowed 90 days in any 180 day period.

All paperwork, including Alpine Performance Racing pre-requisite forms must be completed and returned no later than 14 days prior to the start of the athletes training.

12. If you want to cancel your booking, you must tell us immediately by email to fraser@alpineperformanceracing.co.uk . If you cancel, you will be liable to pay the cancellation charges set out in the table below. Charges depend on the date when we receive your cancellation.*

Cancellation Notification	Cancellation charge
Up to 28 days prior to commencement	25% of total invoice
0-28 days prior to commencement	100% of total invoice

*Payment instalment options for full time athletes are to be settled by the arranged date laid out in their specific plan.
